

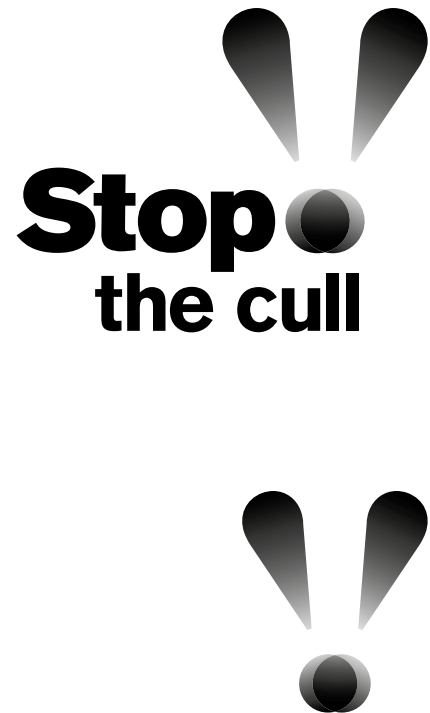


The first licence allowing farmers in England to shoot badgers in an attempt to reduce cattle TB has been issued.
